




Employer audit – coal medicals



Key audit findings:

- Some employers not arranging assessments for new workers
- Some employers reimbursing workers
- Small number of cases worker paid for assessment
- High levels of engagement and cooperation

ResHealth is the online system for the health assessment process for the Coal Mine Workers' Health Scheme.

rom 1 April 2023, ResHealth will be mandatory for the completion of coal mine workers' health assessments, allowing you to submit, monitor and review the progress f your health assessment in a secure online environment.

ResHealth is available for use now and all employers, workers and medical professionals working within the Queensland Coal Mine Workers' Health Scheme are encouraged to commence transitioning to the online platform in advance of 1 April 2023.

ResHealth is one of many Queensland Government online services that require a customer login and uses the secure QGov platform to verify an individual's digital identity.






Respiratory disease cases








