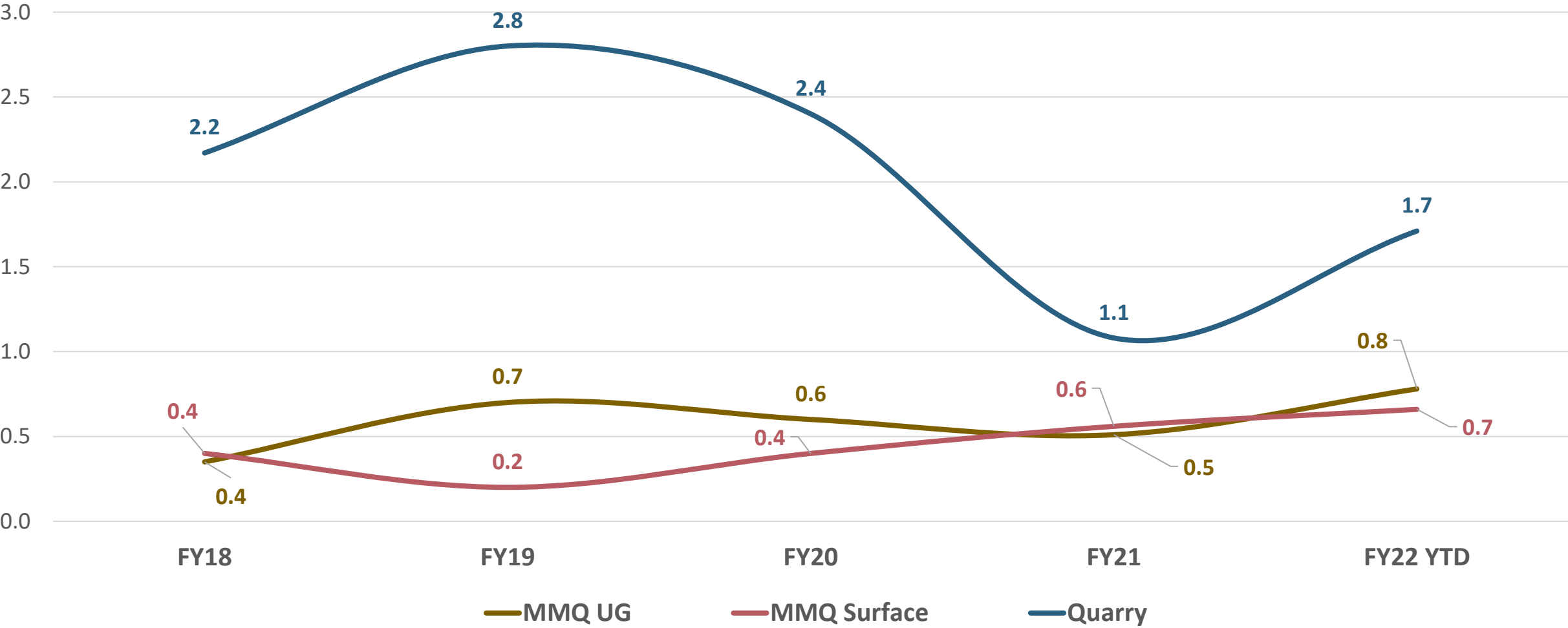

# Brady Review

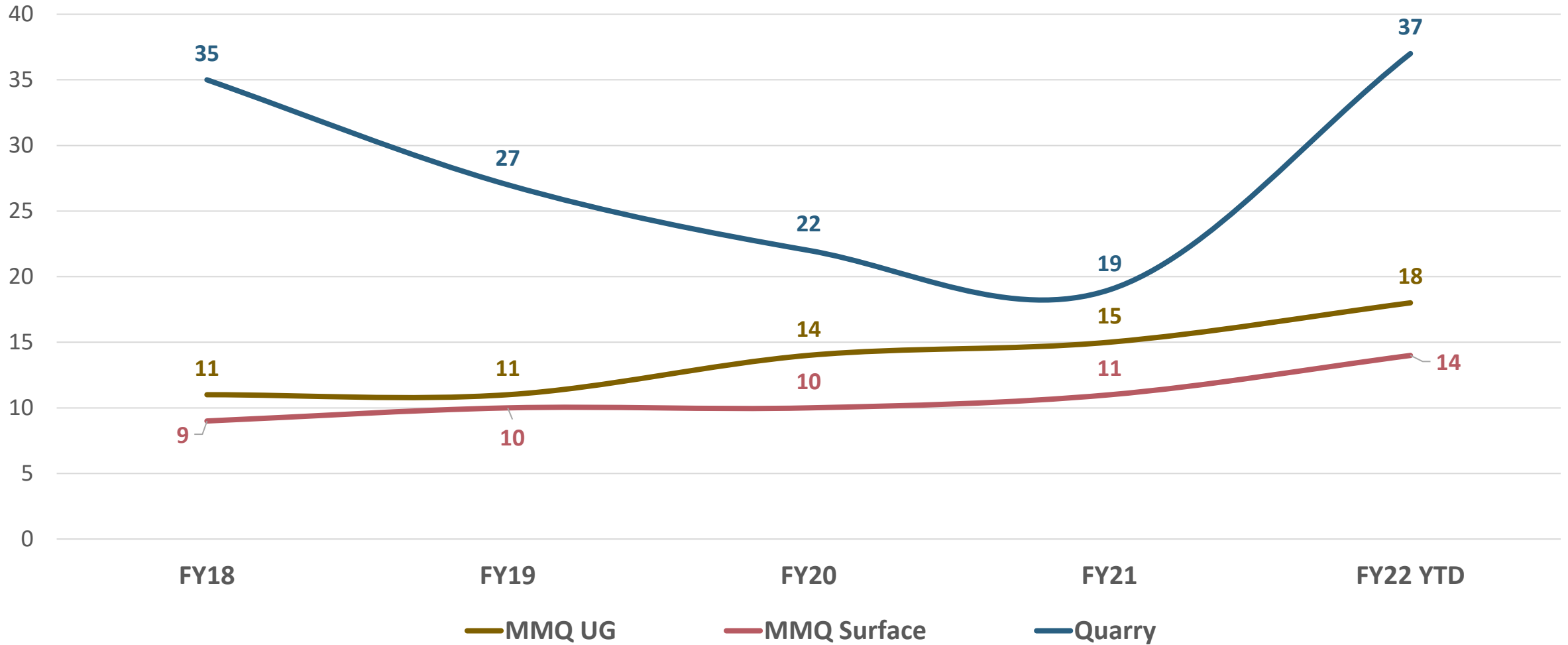
- No longer record LTIFR safety indicators
- Focus on causal factors
- Adoption of SAFR
- Adoption of HPIFR

# Reporting culture

Reporting of HPIs is increasing BUT inspectors still have to argue over definition

***Why is there reluctance to report and learn?***

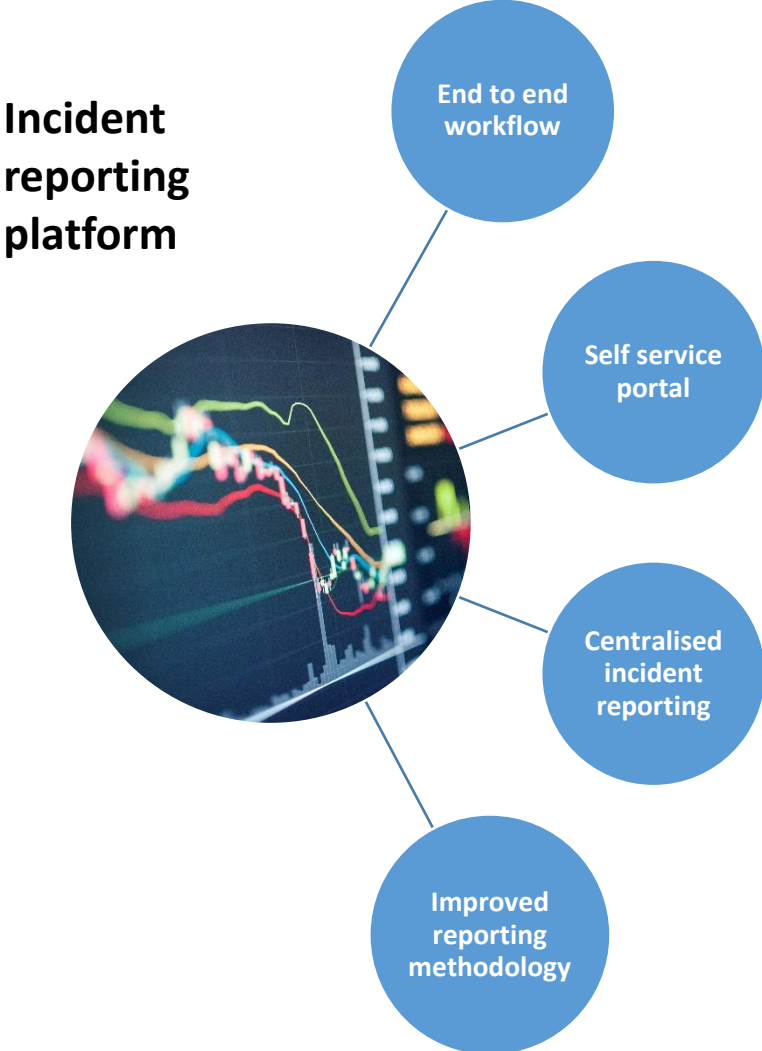
***You must have the courage to promote and support the reporting of 'bad' news***

# What's measured matters

- What does your safety reporting tell you about the safety of your operation?
- Does your reporting demonstrate acceptable risk to workers and encourage reporting of bad news?

- **Include HPIFR in your annual reporting**
- **Set a KPI for increase**

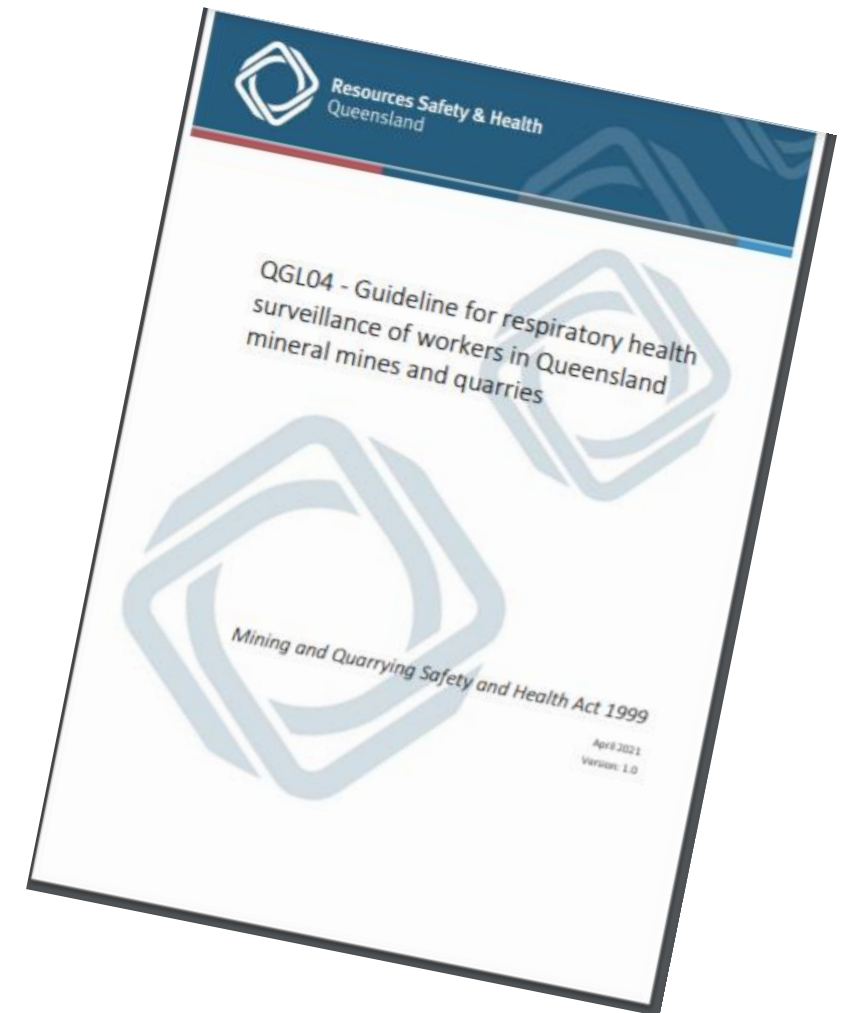

- 1 September 2022 deadline:
  - All workers received initial respiratory health assessment
  - Systems in place for ongoing assessment
- Information and resources available online: templates, approved doctors, guides and videos
